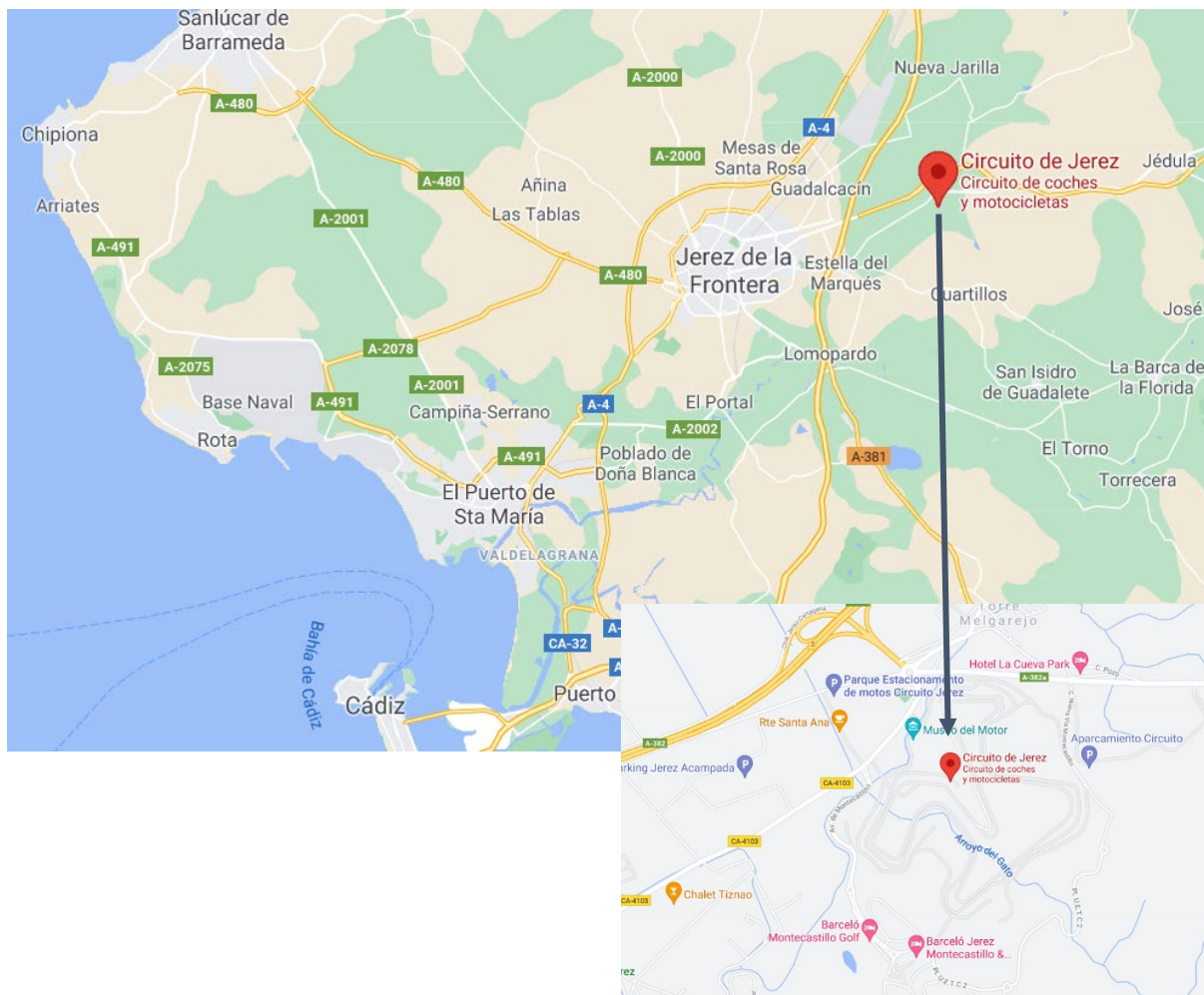

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Travel to and from Spain has been relaxed in recent weeks so please ensure you are aware of the current requirements to travel into Spain. You can find country-specific travel advice at:

Please note that you will need to complete a [Health Control Form](#) 48hours before travelling to Spain.

If you are flying into Portugal, please be aware that travel requirements into Portugal are different to Spain.

EVENT-SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Covid-19:

Temperature checks may be taken at the entrance of the circuit.

The circuit request that you wear a face mask inside any circuit building and when you are not able to practice social distancing of 1.5 meters.

MANDATORY REQUIREMENT: Masters must submit a list of all drivers and their team members and guests who may/will be present at the circuit at any time for the event: please send us a list of these attendees to chiara@mastershistoricracing.com before Wednesday 20 October – we require the first name, last name, email address and mobile phone contact (including country code) for each person.

This App will be the main information portal for all the Masters grids. Please ensure that you and your team sign up to app via the Apple Store or Google Play: search for Masters Historic Racing and join each grid in which you are participating.

CIRCUITS ACCESS, PADDOCKS, TICKETS AND PIT GARAGES

Tickets & Passes:

No tickets or passes will be issued in advance.

Teams arriving on Thursday will gain access via a 'participants list' which we will provide to the circuit.

Tickets and car passes will be issued from Friday morning in the Masters Drivers Club. Please ensure you, or a member of your team, come to collect them.

For any ticket collection requirements from Saturday morning, tickets and car passes can be collected from the accreditation office located at the main entrance/next to gate number 1.

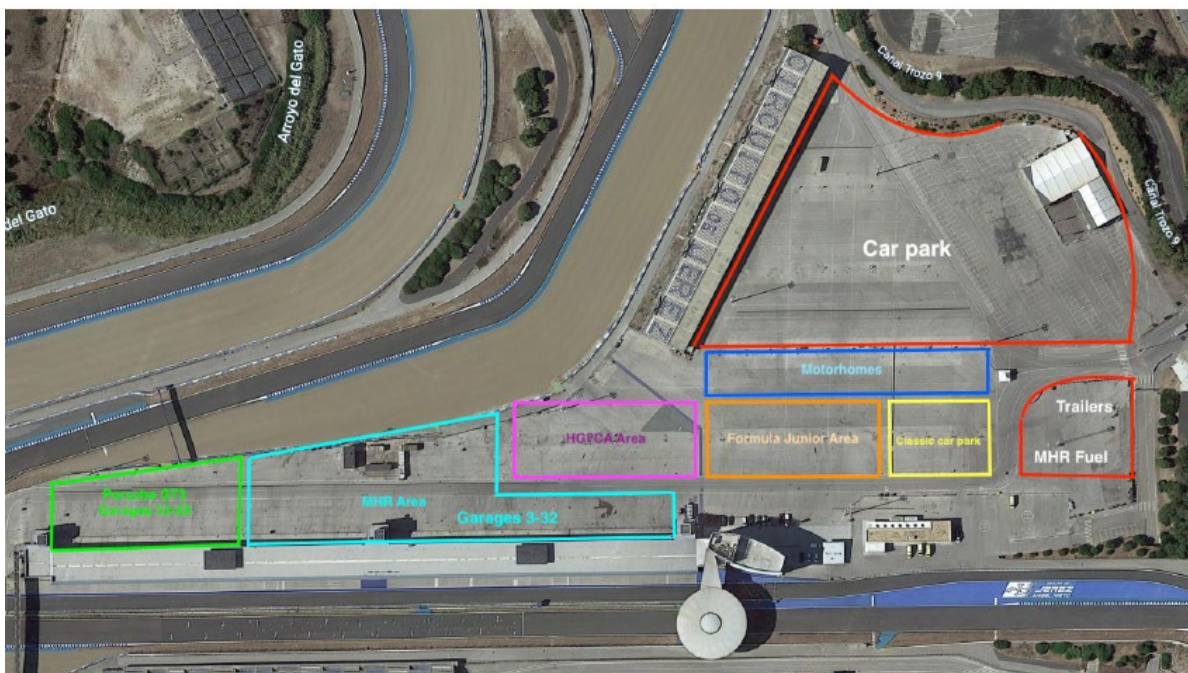
Single driver teams will receive 6 tickets and 1 x 'P1' car pass; 2-driver teams will receive 8 tickets and 2 x 'P1' car passes.

Paddock

The paddock will be open for access from 09h00 on Thursday 21 October. Motorhomes and private cars can park up at the back of the paddock.

Please note that trucks can be left in the paddock until 18h00 on Monday.

Pit Garages

These are available to all Masters entries – you can find the **Final Garage Plan** [here](#).

You can stay in the pit garages until 14h00 on Monday. Keys need to be collected from the Access Counter in the main hall on arrival. You will be asked for a refundable deposit of 50€ in exchange for the garage key.



Masters' Drivers Club

The Masters' Drivers Club will be onsite for the weekend and based in the Paddock. The opening times will be as follows:

- Friday:** from 12h00 to 17h30 (approx.) - hot & cold drinks only
Saturday: from 08h30 to 17h30 (approx.) - full service
Sunday: from 08h00 to 17h30 (approx.) - full service

Each driver is entitled to 2 VIP Drivers Club passes. If you have more than one entry you are entitled to an additional VIP Club pass per entry. Please contact sam@mastershistoricracing.com if you wish to use your Early Bird tickets.

Extra hospitality passes can be also purchased for £30/€35 per person per day (£12.50 for kids under 12 and FOC for under 5s) – please let us know in advance if you need extra hospitality passes by emailing: team@mastershistoricracing.com

PRIVATE TESTING - Friday 22 October

Testing is available to all entries. There is no need to book in advance: simply book your sessions from 07h30 at the circuit from the Escuderia Targa Iberia Counter, located in the hall of the main building. Payment by credit card: 150 euros for a single-session, 250 euros for 2 sessions or 450 euros for 4 sessions.

FUEL: Sunoco's Spanish agent RR2 will be based in the paddock offering a pumped and drum delivery service. You must pre-order your fuel before arrival at the circuit by filling out the following form [here](#).

If you do not require higher-octane fuel, there is no 'regular' fuel station at the circuit but there are stations within close proximity to the circuit.
