



## **COVID GUIDELINES**

### **GENERAL GUIDELINES**

- Always follow the CDC and State/Local COVID guidelines. All participants, Masters Staff, contractors are asked to wear masks all the time.
- Follow guidelines in regards to social distancing, frequent hand washing/hand sanitizer use, face coverings, etc.
- Individuals must be symptom and fever free for a minimum of five (5) days before the event day.
- Certain populations may be at increased personal risk regarding COVID-19, including people over 65 and people with underlying medical conditions.
- It is strongly recommended that participants who meet the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) definition of "People Who are at Higher risk of Severe Illness" not participate in the event.

### **SIGN-ON & REGISTRATION**

- Licence checks will take place at registration. All drivers are required to show their valid race licence to be checked.
- Registration for the event at Laguna Seca will take place Friday from 12pm until 5pm and Saturday from 7am until 12pm. Every person on the crew list is required to wear a mask when picking up the event credentials.
- No Driver Information will be handed out, the Registrars will not handle any clip boards.
- Wristbands will be provided for the participant to put on.

### **TEMPERATURE CHECKS / COVID WAIVER**

- Before entering the track, temperature checks will take place. Each Crew Member has to sign a COVID familiarization waiver provided by the track.

### **RACE ADMINISTRATION/RACE CONTROL**

- No printed results or bulletins will be available to collect. The Results and updated event information such as Drivers Briefings etc will be circulated via eMail.
- Only essential staff will be allowed to access Race Control and Timing&Scoring area. No driver/crew will be allowed into Race Control and Timing&Scoring.

### **GRID / PITLANE**

- Grid Staff and Crews have to wear masks if social distancing is not possible. Only essential crew should be in pitlane and grid.
- Social distance guidelines should be followed and teams should expand the distance between each crew.

### **ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS FOR TEAMS**

- Teams must consider bringing the minimum number of people required to an event.
- Teams are recommended to bring their own first aid kit, etc. to minimise the need to use the circuit medical resources.
- Teams should bring adequate PPE for all personnel and retain a record of those attending the event.



#### **DRIVERS BRIEFINGS**

- The Drivers Briefing will take place outdoors. It will be held at the Masters Historic Racing Series Tent in the Paddock, Row A. Everybody has to maintain social distancing guidelines between each other and wear a mask.

#### **ILLNESS / COVID SYMPTOMS**

- In the case of an illness during the event, you have to leave the area immediately and self-isolate.
- Work with the track medical staff to ensure proper safety measures are in place.
- Clean and sanitize the area the infected person has been or worked before.
- Report the case to Masters Officials and Track Officials.

#### **ILLNESS / COVID SYMPTOMS SHORTLY AFTER THE RACE**

- Report to Masters Officials as contact tracing, should someone begin experiencing symptoms, is critical.
