



COVID-19 - THE CLASSIC 2021

Guidance for International Competitors and Essential Operational or Support Staff

The following document applies to those international competitors and essential operational or support staff that wish to travel to England on a travel exemption letter which exempts them from certain quarantine rules as per the [UK government guidance here](#).

The Classic has been registered with the UK Government as an Elite Sporting Event. Subject to Covid-19 travel restrictions remaining in place, international competitors and essential operational or support staff entering from outside of the UK, must register the full details of their visit prior to entry with Motorsport UK so that [travel exemption letters](#) can be granted by Motorsport UK if required. These can be applied for [here](#). In addition:

- If you are arriving from a green list country and have only been in a green list country in the 10 days before arriving in England then you must take a COVID-19 PCR test on day 2 or earlier after arriving if you are staying in England for 2 days or longer.
- If you are arriving from an amber list country and have been in an amber list country, but not a red list country, in the 10 days before arriving in England then you must quarantine in the place you are staying, whether that be a hotel or motorhome at the event. You can leave your accommodation to participate in your motorsport sessions and then must return to your accommodation. You must not interact with any other activity at the event other than the motorsport activity for which you are there for. If staying in England for longer than 2 days, you must take a COVID-19 PCR test on day 2 and day 8 if you are still in the country.

This document does not apply to those that are travelling to England and have already followed the standard red, amber and green list rules for entering England in advance of the event (as per the [UK government guidance here](#)). i.e. Those that are travelling from:

- red list countries that have quarantined for 10 full days in a managed quarantine hotel, or
- amber list countries that have quarantined at home or in the place you are staying for 10 days, or
- amber list countries that have quarantined at home or in the place you are staying for 5 days AND have received a negative result from a COVID-19 PCR test on day 5 via the Test to Release scheme, or
- amber list countries and have been fully vaccinated under the UK vaccination programme, or
- green list countries

are free to go about your business, enjoy everything the event has to offer and travel anywhere else in England, provided you have also received negative results from any required COVID-19 PCR tests.

Within your roles, you will be also be governed by Motorsport UK guidelines and must adhere to The Classic 2021 Covid-19 Site Safety Rules issued separately.
