

Masters GT Trophy

2023 SERIES ELIGIBILITY LIST

The Masters GT Trophy caters for a wide variety of GT cars that were eligible to enter GT4 race series as well as one-make CUP, Trophy and Challenge series from 2007-2018 inclusive. The series will be open to cars that were eligible to run in such series as Ferrari Challenge, British GT Championship, GT4 Series, Blancpain GT Series, Lamborghini Super Trofeo, Porsche Mobil1 Supercup, Porsche Carrera Cup, Trofeo Maserati, Audi R8 LMS Cup, Lotus Cup from the 2007 to 2018 timeframe. All eligible GT4 cars must be running outside of current homologation.

The Masters GT Trophy will be split into three main year groups (2007-11, 2012-14, 2015-18). Each year group will also be split into three categories for CORSE, CUP and GT4. See below list of eligible cars:
